HEDIS® 2017 Results

HEDIS® is a set of standardized performance measures sponsored, supported, and maintained by the National Committee for Quality Assurance (NCQA). The performance measures in HEDIS® are related to many significant public health issues such as cancer, heart disease, asthma, diabetes, and timely immunizations. HEDIS® evaluates the quality of care received by our members utilizing administrative data obtained through diagnostic codes and procedure codes that are submitted when medical services are billed. When necessary, this data is supplemented by medical record reviews to obtain information regarding services that may not have been reported.

The HEDIS® 2017 results are in! Jai Medical Systems achieved exceptionally well in CY 2016. Thanks to the hard work of our participating providers, Jai Medical Systems scored the highest score in the State of Maryland in childhood immunizations, vaccinations for adolescents, well-child visits for both kids aged 3-6 and adolescents, lead screening in children, asthma medication management, adolescent access to primary care ages 12-19, chlamydia screening in women, HbA1c testing for diabetics, HbA1c control <8.0% for diabetics, and monitoring on persistent medications. Jai Medical Systems also exceeded the National HEDIS mean scores for 2016 in 54 of the 59 measures.

In CY 2017, Jai Medical Systems continues to focus on HEDIS® measures related to the treatment of asthma and hypertension by ensuring that qualifying members are offered the opportunity to enroll in our Disease Management Programs and our Health Education Programs. Jai Medical Systems also continues to offer a prevention program for patients at risk of developing type 2 diabetes. So far, we have over 110 patients enrolled in this program. We greatly appreciate your efforts in ensuring that our members continue to receive the highest quality health care possible.
